About Us

UPHOTO is a professional digital imaging and photographic processing laboratory offering a complete line of printing, processing, framing, studio rental and other services. Photographers and businesses with photographic needs have found our lab services to be among the finest available anywhere. We work hard to maintain our commitment to the highest quality standards.

Location and Business Hours

We are located in Beltsville, Maryland three miles north of the Capital Beltway and one block off U.S. Route 1 at 5005 Garrett Avenue. We are open Monday-Friday, 10:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. for full service, and Saturday 11:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. for pick-up and drop-off only. Night drop is also available.

Terms of Sale / Deposits

All orders picked up at our lab are C.O.D. payable by cash, check, VISA, MasterCard, Discover, American Express or Debit card. Open account terms are available only to approved clients. A 50% deposit will be required on rush work and orders over \$100. Orders requiring special handling, or third party delivery must be pre-paid in full before the work is started. Mail orders must be prepaid by check, credit card or money order. A minimum handling charge of \$6.00 will apply to all orders shipped by UPS, Priority Mail, FEDEX or courier. A service charge of \$30.00 will be assessed on all returned checks. We will not be responsible for orders unclaimed after 30 days.

Service Times

Our goal is to complete your order as quickly as possible while maintaining our high quality standards. The delivery times listed in each section are <u>estimated</u>, based on average service times, and work loads. Many factors, some beyond our control, can affect delivery so please mention a specific deadline which must be met when your order is placed. Open lab or rush premium charges may be required to meet deadlines. Every effort will be made to accommodate your needs. During seasonal peak times, orders may encounter unavoidable production delays. We recommend that you call ahead to verify that orders are ready for pick up.

Order Change Fee / Cancellation Fee

If work has not been started on an order, a fee of \$5.00 *may* be assessed to change or cancel the order. If the order has been completed prior to the requested change, the full cost of the original order will be charged in addition to the requested changes. Please note that order changes can cause delivery delays. Partially completed orders will be billed for the finished portion.

Minimum Order Charge

A minimum order charge of \$3.00 applies to most orders. Selected services may have higher minimum order fees.

Rush Service and Open Lab

Many services are available on a rush basis, including while-you wait. Rush times and availability vary by service type, and options will be listed in each section. A minimum charge of \$10.00 applies to all rush orders and a 50% deposit is required for *ALL* rush work. During seasonal peaks, some rush services may not be available. Standard rush service is limited to regular production hours. Open lab charges of \$80 per hour will apply to orders requiring after-hours or weekend production time. Before making rush delivery commitments to your clients, please check with us to verify that delivery of the required service will be available.

Reorders

Because of variations inherent to all photographic processes, a new reorder may not precisely match prints from a previous order. If you require a close match and can provide a guide print, we will do our best to get as close as possible to your sample. Be aware that when guide prints are made on different paper brands or surfaces, or scanned from originals it might not be possible to achieve a perfect match. While great care is exercised in completing your work, we cannot be responsible for the cost of remakes due to omitted or inadequate instructions or lack of necessary color or density guides.

Remake Policy

Our goal is to produce the highest quality work and we take great care in the completion of every order. On the rare occasion that an order needs to be remade, it is essential that the undamaged print(s) are returned with the original work order, negatives or digital files, and a written explanation of the desired correction. Requests for remakes at NO CHARGE must be received within TEN DAYS of receipt of the original order, otherwise the remade order will be billed at the regular fee.

Understanding and incorporating good color management practices into your workflow are the keys that will enable you to create high quality digital products for your clients. We are happy to help you find a solution that works best for your specific needs. When you check out website at www.uphoto.com, you will find useful links to many great resources. In addition, we have created a section for photo tips written by staff, clients and leading photo professionals. We believe these tips can provide valuable insight into digital equipment, exposure control and lighting, color management, file manipulation and other areas of interest. We encourage you to explore our website and provide us with feedback so that we may improve your experience.

At Uphoto, we are here to assist you by sharing our many years of experience and answering your technical questions. We also offer classes and workshops where students are provided hands-on instruction in lighting, posing, and digital imaging. Please browse the Workshop section in this catalog and check our latest offerings on our website.

Monitor Calibration

Monitor calibration is the single most important component of your workflow. If your monitor is properly calibrated, the prints we make for you will closely match the image displayed on your screen. The most reliable calibration will be achieved by using a plug-in on-screen device and software package. Fuji, X-rite, Gretag-Macbeth and others make affordable monitor profiling kits. They can range widely in price, but can save you many times their cost in lost time and print remakes. We recommend that you visually confirm the accuracy of your calibrated monitor to our output devices. You can download a Target Print File and output profiles from our website. You will also need a free "Target Print" sample. This will enable you to reliably "soft-proof" your own images. The following procedure assumes you are using Adobe PhotoShop, but can be adapted to other programs. Just follow these steps:

- Download the required output profile from our website, then "rightclick" on the file and select "Install Profile".
- Launch PhotoShop and open the target print file on your computer.
- In PhotoShop, click the "View" menu and select "Proof Setup" and "Custom". Under "Customize Proof Condition", locate the desired profile (Frontier or Chromira) under "Device to Simulate". Make sure you select "Perceptual" Rendering Intent and un-check "Black Point Compensation". Select "Save" and name the setup for the desired output device. When selected, this setup should now closely match the color & density of the specified output device.
- If you are using Presentation Gold, you can use the master balance
 offset under "Preferences" to correct any differences you see in
 the finished print and your preview screen. If you are using other
 software, you can "fine-tune" your monitor screen controls
 (contrast, red, green and blue) to match the reference print. It is
 important that the print is viewed under a light source that is close
 to "daylight" color balance.
- When the print & monitor are in close agreement, you should send us a corrected test image for printing using one of your files. Once you receive the new print, compare and "fine- tune" the screen if necessary. After this process has been completed, your monitor and the prints we make for you should be in very close agreement.

ICC Profiles

We use the sRGB color space on our Frontier and Chromira photographic imaging equipment. Our Epson 9800 & 9900 printers use the Adobe 1998 color space for Studio Giclee's. Mismatches of these two color spaces can produce unintended results, so be sure to submit files in the appropriate color space for the desired output type. We suggest you use "Perceptual" for the rendering intent.

The sRGB space also matches the working color space used by most computer monitors. Make sure that the default working color space in Photoshop or your raw file processor is also set to sRGB. Although files shot in Adobe 1998 can be converted to sRGB, this will simply add time to file preparation with no direct quality benefit when printing to our Frontier or Chromira equipment.

Your monitor should be located in a stable viewing environment where the ambient lighting will be always be the same. It should be calibrated and set to a white point of 6500 k and a Gamma of 2.2. This is defined in the sRGB color space, and is standard on Windows PC's. If you are using a MAC, you may need to change the gamma setting to 2.2. CRT displays usually work a little better than LCD flat panels. Avoid laptop displays for critical color correction as they tend to be "cold" and contrasty, and cannot be reliably calibrated to provide consistent color values.

Digital File Requirements

Uphoto can print any file format that can be opened in Photoshop. When ordering Frontier prints, we request that you submit files as 200-300 PPI, 8 bit sRGB Level 10 or 11 Baseline Standard JPEG's. Files supplied in other formats may cause production delays. If you are ordering Chromira, Ultrachrome HDR, or Studio Giclee prints TIF files are preferred. When ordering large prints 16x20 or bigger, while lower resolution files may also be acceptable, but please check with us first. Please do not "up-res" smaller files to a higher DPI, as this will not significantly improve quality but will slow file transfers.

File names must contain only letters, numbers, dashes and spaces, followed by the .jpg file extension. Please note that the use of any of the following characters has been proven to cause problems and will delay your order !@#\$%^&*()+=:;."',<>`~\| Keep the file names as short as possible, for example "JK001.jpg" not "Jim and Kathy's wedding DSC 0001.jpg"

If you must submit PSD, or TIF files, please provide them on a CD or DVD. Special arrangements can be made to transfer large files to our FTP server, but these transfers can sometimes delay your order. Please remember that while level 10 jpegs work great for most printing applications, you should save original files as raw, TIF or PSD to prevent cumulative compression losses and file degradation from repeated saving after making edits to your images.

Our system is built to provide a *Total Solution* for the photographer who would prefer to spend less time with production, organizing, ordering and studio management. The *Preview Gallery* was designed by Professional Photographers and experienced Studio and Lab Managers.

MAC users can access the *Preview Gallery* on-line Dashboard to securely upload images to their Gallery without any additional software to install. This easy to use interface provides the tools needed to manage events and web page content, make price and product changes or track your sales with detailed reports. You can place orders for prints and other products with the integrated ftp up loader, or create incredible composite album pages with the new on-line *Freestyle Album Designer*. Give your wedding clients a direct link to the site where they can review the album design you have created. Changes can be made in a snap without re-doing entire pages. Don't worry, images displayed on the website can not be copied or downloaded.

Our Dashboard utilizes custom *Java* applets to manage files on the *Preview Gallery* and create print orders. When creating a new gallery, you can choose to use the *Express* option, and the full resolution files will be uploaded and stored on our local server. This way, when your clients place an order, it will be automatically transferred to our production system and be ready for printing without any intervention on your part. For a small additional fee, we will even drop ship the order directly to your client. If you have a Pay Pal account, you can collect payments directly from your client. We bill you only for the cost of the print order and shipping.

If you are a Windows PC user, the stand-alone PC software provides easy access to your *Preview Gallery* for image uploading, event management, print ordering, image adjustment, and includes a complete album page design system. The PC application is called *Presentation Gold*, and also provides users an easy way to transfer files from memory cards and quickly rename and organize images. In addition, you can color correct, rotate and crop your images, all without making destructive changes to the original jpeg. TIF or JPEG images, or scans from roll film can be used with this system. The *Preview Gallery* is also accessible on-line so you can securely manage events, upload images, track sales, order prints and design album pages with the *Freestyle Album Designer* from any computer with internet access without installing any additional software.

You can also choose to upload your files to the on-line *Preview Gallery* and provide a safe, easy to use system with a shopping cart and on-line payment option for your clients to order prints over the internet. The print orders are created by the client, and e-mailed to your computer where *Presentation Gold* automatically retrieves the necessary files, and prepares them for transmission to Uphoto. Just a few mouse clicks are all that are required to send us the job. The easy to use album page designer included with *Presentation Gold* will greatly reduce the time needed to create composite pages. Additionally, the composites are produced in a format that allows each image element to be individually color corrected, cropped or replaced before printing. Hundreds of pre-built templates are provided free of charge, and templates you may already be using can be imported into the program for use with the system. A template designer utility is also included to allow you to create your own designs in any size or configuration.

The *Presentation Gold* print ordering system is fast and easy to use. By entering your studio's pricing information for each print size, an order summary report and invoice can be generated for each job. The program also includes an automatic utility to access our remote FTP server, and securely transfer your jobs to our lab. It will even will send you a receipt confirmation by e-mail. Orders prepared with *Presentation Gold or Preview Gallery Dashboard* qualify for discounted pricing on many services.

Many of our clients have been asking for a solution for dealing with RAW digital files. They want to take advantage of the security that the extended exposure latitude and color correction range RAW shooting provides, but find the ordeal of correcting and processing the large images shot in this enhanced format too time consuming or confusing.

We are pleased to offer a service that will free you from the time consuming burden of working in RAW (well, most of it - you still have to download your own memory cards!). We will professionally optimize and color correct your RAW digital files, perform a rough edit (crop and/or rotate) and convert them into hi-res JPEG's, ready for printing or uploading to your Preview Gallery. We can also prepare images to your specification for delivery to your client on CD or DVD.

If you are more comfortable shooting JPEG's, we can often provide dramatic improvements to your uncorrected images with this service. We also will store your enhanced files for up to one year on our server at no additional cost.

A BIG advantage of having us correct your RAW or JPEG images is that they will usually qualify for our "Ready-to-Print" option if your order is created and submitted through our Preview Gallery site or your Presentation Gold software.

Please provide your RAW or JPEG files on CD, DVD or other removable media. We have computers available in our customer service area if you prefer to download your images directly to our in-house print server. The Giclée Fine Art Print

A Giclée (zhee-clay) is a fine art inkjet print produced to exacting standards on archival media substrates. The process was pioneered in the early 1990's by rock legend Graham Nash and his business associate Mac Holbert. By modifying proven printer technology and combining it with their proprietary pigment inks, they ushered in a new era of fine art print making. To distinguish their new process, they coined the term "Giclée", which was derived from the french verb gicler meaning to spray or squirt, which describes the function of the printhead. Today, the term Giclée suggests a superior elevation in the printmaking craft. Images are captured as high resolution digital scans and then printed with pigmented inks onto archival papers and other materials with fade resistance of 50 - 120 years under average indoor light conditions. When combined with superior craftsmanship, the Giclée process provides better color accuracy and permanence than other means of reproduction.

Giclée's are advantageous to artists who find it is not feasible to mass produce their work, but still want to create limited editions of their art as needed. Once an image is finalized and archived, additional reproductions can be made with minimal effort and cost. Thus the upfront cost of mass production is greatly reduced and printing is done on demand. Another tremendous advantage to Giclée printing is that art can be reproduced to almost any size and on various media, giving the artist the ability to customize prints for a specific client or purpose. Multiple sizes can be produced to fit marketing needs.

The process begins with digital capture or scanning. We photograph your art with our Phase One PowerPhase FX Scanning back, which is one of the world's highest resolution capture devices. An image captured by the FX can hold more information than 8"x10" sheet film and can deliver more accurate color with a wider dynamic range. Alternatively, we can scan client supplied large format transparencies with excellent results. Smaller flat art up to 11"x17" can be captured in high resolution on one of our professional flatbed scanners.

The second step is image setup, correction and manipulation. This is when we remove dust or other unwanted artifacts from the scan or digital capture. Flaws in the original can be corrected, or local color and density corrections to specific areas can be made. We strongly encourage artist input during this part of the process as it will greatly improve the chances of producing the best reproduction. This is also where we establish final size, border configurations, and select the print media.

Once the artist is satisfied with the "soft" proof on the computer workstation, we make a Giclée proof print on the selected media to verify the corrections made in the setup process. Slight variations sometimes occur between the computer's screen and the printer and media, and this is the best way to find out if anything needs to be changed. It may be necessary to make a new proof after any corrections are made. Once final approval is given, we ask the artist to sign the back of the selected proof, and this will be held for color match to the final print.

At last, the full size Giclée print is produced on one of our wide format Epson printers. The image is archived for future use, and a CD is produced for the artist as a backup.
